

# *COLLEGE PREPARATION RECOMMENDATIONS*

*STUDENTS WHO PLAN TO ATTEND A FOUR YEAR UNIVERSITY SHOULD TAKE ADDITIONAL ACADEMIC COURSES BEYOND THE MINIMAL STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. THE ACADEMIC PREPARATION OF THE COLLEGE BOUND STUDENT SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:*

LANGUAGE ARTS: (4) credits [AP Language Arts recommended] with emphasis in composition and literature.

MATHEMATICS: (2) credits beyond Elementary Algebra

SCIENCE: (3) credits with laboratory experience in one.

HISTORY: (1) credit in US History/Government

FOREIGN LANGUAGE: (2) consecutive years of the same language to be completed during grades 7-12.

ADDITIONAL CREDIT: (4) credits to be chosen from at least two of the following: history, Language Arts, mathematics beyond Intermediate Algebra, science (with Laboratory), foreign language, social science, fine arts. Computer science also recommended.

## *MAKEUP POLICIES*

### **ACADEMIC:**

Loss of academic credit can be made up through one of the following methods with prior counselor approval.

1. Millcreek High School instructional clinics: These clinics are held after school, and the cost is \$50.00 per .25 credit.
2. Millcreek High School summer school: the cost is \$50.00 per .25 credit
3. Approved and accredited homestudy (i.e. BYU or USU homestudy): The cost is approximately \$98.00 per .50 credit plus text.
4. Packet from Snow Canyon High school: \$50.00 per .25 credit.
